

## *Connecting to SVAKO Wi-Fi with Windows XP..*

  1. In the lower right corner of the screen of the Notification area in System tray find the wireless internet icon and right-click on it.
  - .
    2. In the window select "*Open network connections*".
    3. In the window find the Wireless network connection and click on it and select Properties.
    4. Select a tab *Wireless Networks* and put a checkmark on *Use Windows to configure my wireless network settings*. Then click *Add*..
    5. In the Card Association, in the box *Network name (SSID)*, in capital letters write network name (SVAKO). In the field *Network Authentication* indicate WPA2 and *Data encryption - AES*.
    6. In the card Authentication, 1) in the field *EAP type* choose Protected EAP (PEAP). 2) click Properties; 3) in the open window uncheck Validate server certificate.
    7. 4) In the field *Select Authentication Method* choose *Secured password (EAPMSCHAP v2)* and click *Configure*.. Next uncheck *Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)*.
    - .
      8. Close all windows by clicking *OK*.
      9. Repeat step 1, but now select *View Available Wireless Networks*.
      10. In the open window choose SVAKO Wi-Fi and click *connect*.
      11. After repeating step 1 a new window should appear in which you have to log in
      - .

In *User name* field enter login name SVAKO ID  
Password: SVAKO ID password.  
Leave *Logon domain* field empty.
